

Adoption of the Fair Share Housing Model Estimated Production Numbers

In an unprecedented vote, New Hampshire's Council on Housing Stability unanimously adopted the State's Fair Share Housing Production Model's estimated production numbers developed through a collaboration between the state's nine Regional Planning Commissions (RPC) and New Hampshire Housing (NHHFA). The Model was funded by the Community Development Finance Authority (CDFA) and coordinated by staff at the BEA. This is the first time statewide numbers will guide local communities to reach their housing production goals.

The Fair Share Housing Production Model estimates a community's anticipated housing production need based on that area's projected population and employment growth and projects that the State of New Hampshire will need an additional 88,363 housing units by 2040.
